REGISTRATION LANGUAGE	Please join us for a second virtual public scoping meeting during the public comment period for the Draft Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for the Zenith Properties Building Demolition Application.					
	It is one of several ways the public may provide comment on the scope of the Draft EIS. You can also comment using traditional mail or our online comment form. The virtual meeting will be held on Monday, August 15, at 6 pm. Participants should register in advance and public join at 6 pm sharp.					
	The virtual meeting will include a short presentation, a question and answer session about the EIS process, and a public comment forum through the Zoom platform. Participants must register in advance and join from a computer or tablet on the Zoom platform in order to provide verbal comment during this event. The meeting will conclude when the last registered participant has given comment. Comments will be received in alphabetical order by last name.					

	This meeting will be recorded by Zoom and all comments during the formal comment period will be documented for official public record.						
FORMAT	Platform and Registration  We will use the Zoom webinar platform.  Participants will register online at the link above. All participants must provide first name, last name, physical address, and email address.  Participants will mark "yes" when registering if they plan to make a public comment. Participants who wish to give comment will need to use the Zoom platform via computer, tablet or smartphone app.  Participants who join by Zoom link can use either computer audio or phone audio.  The team will also provide a "call in" number if people wish to follow the meeting audio. Call in participants will not be able to provide comment during this meeting.  Presentation and Public Comment  The presentation will begin with an introduction of staff and an overview of the event.  Those joining by Zoom platform will see the presentation slides, see panelists and hear the presenter's voice.  All public participants will be muted when joining.  Participants will be able to ask questions through a Q&A window.  Pamela will select questions that are relevant to the EIS and direct them to the project team as needed.  Colleen will announce the start of the public comment session.  Colleen will announce each person who identified that they would like to make a public comment. Frana will "unmute" public participants one-by-one on Zoom to provide individual comment.  A court reporter will transcribe the entire meeting, including the public comments.
